

Many of these are descended from the 1870s immigrants who came with, or followed, Daniel Unruh (1820-1893) and his group from Bruderfeld, Crimea. They were the first Russian Mennonites to settle in Dakota Territory. They began to arrive in 1874 then formed the Brothersfield Mennonite Brethren congregation in 1876. Within six years over half went to the Adventists who, within another ten years all left for North Dakota where, starting about 1900, they settled in New Home, near Woodworth.


By 1920 most of the 1st generation had died. Their children began to migrate into Canada and Oklahoma, but most came to California and settled near Shafter.

Sixty-one of the descendants in the above photo have been identified. I hope these pages will prompt others to help identify even more.






